



# TFI™ Test

The *Test de français international, TFI™*, evaluates the listening and reading proficiency of people in the French language, whose native language is not French. The test results show how well people can communicate in French in business and academic environments. The *TFI™* test is recognized as proof of a person's French-language competence by businesses and universities worldwide, when considering potential candidates for admission to their organizations.

Since the 1st of January, 2012, the *TFI™* Naturalization test has also been available. A score of 160 (B1 level) in the test fulfils "the proof of language skills" when applying for French citizenship, as set out by the French Immigration Authorities. The *TFI™* Naturalization test assesses only listening comprehension.

## Test Format

- Non-incremental placement test with CEFR\* mapping (no pass-or-fail exam)
- Paper and pencil
- Administered in authorized *TFI™* test centers
- Individual test sessions available by appointment

## Language Level

A1-C1 in accordance with CEFR\*

## Usage

- Evaluation and certification of the receptive French-language skills for job starters and professionals with basic knowledge
- Placement, progress monitoring and exit test for French-language trainings programs

## Structure

Listening: 90 multiple choice questions in 42 min.  
Reading: 90 multiple choice questions in 68 min.
